ALABAMA ASSOCIATION OF REGIONAL COUNCILS 2008 EXHIBIT CONTRACT TERMS & CONDITIONS

Standard booth arrangements: The contract price includes: 8ft.x10ft booth, colored drape 8 feet high at back and 39 inches high on sides, one skirted table six feet long, two chairs, booth identification sign, and name badges.

Assignment of space: Space will be allocated first with preference given to the meeting's content. Special considerations will be given to exhibitors with multiple booths.

Exhibitor hours: Exhibit Hall will be open during breakfast and during breaks and every effort will be made to maximize exposure to the exhibitor. Specific hours will be confirmed at a later date.

Terms: Please send check payable to AARC, with Exhibit/Sponsor form, to 5900 Carmichael Place, Montgomery, AL 36117.

Cancellation: **A:** Any exhibitor desiring to cancel exhibit space for the meeting shall notify AARC in writing at 5900 Carmichael Place, Montgomery, AL 36117, or faxed to (334) 277-3899. Cancellations before September 19, 2008 will be charged a fee of \$250.00. A cancellation after September 19, 2008 obligates the exhibitor to full payment of rental to assure the best available booth locations to AARC meeting exhibitors. **B: Failure to pay:** Failure to send payment in full at time of application voids any contract. **C: Failure to occupy space:** Space not occupied by the close of the installation period as specified in the accompanying material will be forfeited by the exhibitor and this space may be reassigned.

Decorator: The official contractor for the meeting will be Gulf Coast Audio Visual Producers, Inc. Other special requirements not provided through this contract are available through the decorator.

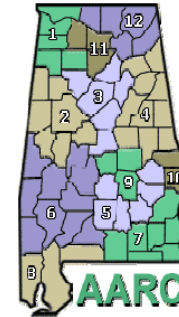
Installation and Dismantling of Exhibits: Exhibit set-up is from 12:00am-3:00pm on October 19, 2008. Tear-down is after breakfast on October 21st and all exhibits must be removed by noon on that day. No exhibits may be erected after the exhibition opens or may be dismantled before the official closing time. Setting up, tearing down, and removal of exhibits are the responsibility of the exhibitor. Should the exhibit fail to be removed, the removal will be arranged by the conference management at the exhibitor's expense.

Protection of hotel property: Acceptance of exhibit space makes it obligatory on the part of the exhibitors that they shall not deface, injure, or mark the exhibit area. Any damage occurring from the exhibition shall be paid by the exhibitor.

Limitation of liability: It is agreed that exhibitors will assume entire responsibility and hereby agree to protect, indemnify, and defend and save the Alabama Association of Regional Councils, The Perdido Beach Resort, and Veal Convention Services and their employees and agents harmless against all claims, losses, and damages to persons or property, government charges or fines and attorneys fees arising out of or caused by exhibitor's installation, removal, maintenance, occupancy or use of exhibition premises or a part thereof fees arising out of or caused by sole negligence of The Perdido Beach Resort, its employees and agents. In addition, exhibitors acknowledge that the Alabama Association of Regional Councils, The Perdido Beach Resort and Veal Convention Services do not maintain insurance covering exhibitor's property and that it is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain business interruption and property damage insurance covering such losses by exhibitor.
